About Steven Brown



His teachers encouraged him to follow a career in art. However, he left school in 1987 and began working in retail. In 1992, Steven married his wife Caroline and moved to Irvine in North Ayrshire. They share three children and two grandchildren together.

Career

Surprisingly, it was just around six years ago that Steven Brown began painting again. He was focusing on improving his technique and finding his own style. Now Steven Brown is a full-time artist who has a love for colour. Normally, he chooses to work with acrylic paint and palette knives. Not only does he make and sell paintings but he also has a range of accessories printed with his designs, such as phone cases, mugs, placemats, cushions and even suitcases!

The McCoos

The McCoo range is said to be the artist's most popular collection. It's a range of brightly painted highland cows each with



a traditionally Scottish name. The paintings first became available to buy online and the business grew from here with customers requesting their very own McCoo design. Famously he designed 'Marie McCoo' to raise money for the cancer charity Marie Curie.

He has created his own style through the use of bright colours and developed his technique for applying paint to canvases. Typically, he works with acrylic paints and palette knifes to create his pieces. Now, not only does he make and sell paintings, but he also has a popular range of accessories printed with his designs including phone cases, mugs, placemats, cushions, coasters and even suitcases!

The McCoos

Steven Brown's McCoo paintings are instantly recognisable for their bold and bright colours. They are said to be some of the artist's most

famous pieces. He first began selling his paintings online but never expected they would be as successful as they were! Customers contacted him to request their very own McCoo, each with their unique characteristics and Scottish name! Famously, he designed the 'Marie McCoo', a delightful cow with a daffodil in her hair, to raise money for the cancer charity Marie Curie.

Unfortunately, the budding artist put his dreams on hold and began working in retail to support himself financially. Soon after, he met his wife Caroline whom he married in 1992. He moved to Irvine in North Ayrshire and they went on to have three children and two grandchildren.

Career

Remarkably, it has only been over the past six years that Steven Brown has become an established and successful artist. He has created his own style and developed his technique for applying paint to canvases after being inspired by contemporary and abstract artists. Quickly, he has become a full-time artist whose trademark is using the bold bright colours that he adores. Typically, he chooses to work with acrylic paints and palette knifes to create his pieces. His work, however, is available in a range of products, not just canvases, including a popular range of accessories printed with his designs like phone cases, mugs, placemats, cushions, coasters and even suitcases!

The McCoos

Steven Brown's McCoo paintings are instantly recognisable for their vibrant colours. The multi-coloured highland cows are said to be some of the artist's most famous

pieces. The paintings were first made available online and immediately grew popular worldwide, with customers soon requesting their very own McCoo to be designed with their unique characteristics and even a Scottish name! His canvases can cost anything from around £49 - £150. Famously, he designed the 'Marie McCoo', a delightful cow with a daffodil in her hair, to raise money for the cancer charity Marie Curie.
